



## STATEWIDE EDUCATION FACT SHEET

- The Florida Lottery was created by a constitutional amendment in 1986 for the purpose of generating additional moneys for public education in the state of Florida.
- More than **\$39 billion** has been transferred to the Educational Enhancement Trust Fund (EETF) since the sale of the Lottery's first ticket in 1988.
- For the 19<sup>th</sup> consecutive fiscal year, the Florida Lottery has transferred more than **\$1 billion** to the EETF – including **\$2.2 billion** in FY 2020-21.
- Florida's public schools (Pre-K and K-12 programs and school construction) have received more than **\$21.2 billion** since the Lottery's inception.
- The Florida Lottery has funded more than **\$6.8 billion** in Bright Futures scholarships allowing more than **880,000** students to attend college.
- Florida's public colleges and universities have also benefited, receiving a combined total of more than **\$10.5 billion** since the Lottery's inception.
